Supply List

Paints

Please try to have tube paint instead of the dry cake style. Any good brand will work but do not get Student Grade.

These are some of the colors I normally have on my palette:

Indian Yellow, Nickel Azo Yellow, Quinacridone Gold or at least a transparent yellow.

Magenta, Alizarin Crimson or Quinacridone Red

Ultramarine, Prussian and Indigo Blue

Burnt Sienna, Van Dyke Brown or equivalent brown

Black, Purple, Yellow—Green, Leaf Green, Skips Green (several names for that one), Olive Green DO NOT BRING HOOKERS GREEN!

Brushes

Synthetic Brushes are okay but try to have some brushes that are a combination of synthetic/natural combination (sable).

1" Flat

½" Flat

#12 Round

#6 Round

#2 or #3 Rigger (outliner)

Paper

You can't go wrong with Arches 140#, several ¼ sheets. Any good brand will work but stay away from the 90# cheaper brands like Strathmore, etc. I will furnish some cheaper paper for experimentation.

Misc. Stuff

Small pocket knife or palette knife with a round tip.

Water pot.

Several rags or paper towels.

Small spritz bottle.

¾" masking tape (very low tack).

Board to tape your paper to (waterproof).

Maybe a block of wood or other material that would fit under your board to help tilt it up 10-15 degrees.

Oh and don't forget the kitchen sink!
