FAQ

The Boone Plein Air event is held rain or shine, October 15 and 16, 2022 (Saturday & Sunday). Efforts have been made to identify indoor locations in case of rain.

Accepted mediums: oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, ink, charcoal, and pencil (or a mixture of these). **Your artwork must be framed and wired for hanging at the time of submission.**

All work is to be completed 100% en plein air. Working from any type of photo or photographic device is strictly forbidden.

If you paint on private property please obtain permission and respect privacy.

All canvases and paper media must be stamped before you begin painting. Stamping station will be available at Elderblossom View Orchard & Winery. Stamping begins at 7am on both days. No work without the official stamp will be accepted for judging.

To be considered for the purchase awards for Saturday, Eagle Knoll Golf Course Quick Paint, Paint Out at Windmill and Dutton Memorial, your piece must be submitted no later than 7:30pm on Saturday and 3:00pm on Sunday at Elderblossom View for judging. **Your piece must be framed and wired for hanging at the submission.**

The location for the Quick Paint (Saturday) will be at the Eagle Knoll Golf Course. Materials will need to receive a special stamp starting at 4:30pm and the start time of the Quick Paint will be 5pm. You may scout a location and set up prior to the 5pm start time but do not start your piece until you hear the kick-off buzzer. You will have two hours to finish your piece. All pieces to be considered will need to be submitted no later than 7:30pm at Elderblossom View. **Your piece must be framed and wired for hanging at the time of submission.**

All work submitted must be for sale. As noted in the registration, Mid-Missouri Arts Alliance (MMAA) will retain a 35% commission on all sales. Artwork can be left with MMAA at the gallery in Ashland until November 19, 2022.

Judging, Awards and Exhibit:

To be considered for the overall judging work must be turned in Saturday by 7:30pm and on Sunday by 3pm. A total of 4 pieces will be considered for judging. Any additional artwork produced may be placed for sale AFTER the judge has finished their determinations.

Artists are eligible to win any combination of awards. Winning a Purchase Award does not preclude artists from winning one of the top three awards. We also will have VIP sponsors that get first pick on artwork available before the reception. Each VIP sponsor has donated \$100 or more.

Committee members for MMAA are not eligible for the cash prizes though they may still be awarded the award itself. Any cash prize won by a committee member will be distributed between remaining awards.

MMAA has procured a limited number of host families for artists. These will be distributed on a first come, first serve basis. After you have registered for the event contact us directly for more information about host families .

NEW this year...we are offering 3 scholarships to high school students that would like to participate in the plein air. This will be for experience only, they will not be able to sell their work at the reception. Students may apply on our website. If you are interested in being a mentor to one of these students please email us and we will pair you with a student.
